



### **Recipe of the Month**

#### **Healthy Bruschetta Sauce**



5 Roma tomatoes (remove peel and dice)

3/4 cup fresh basil, chopped finely

2 garlic cloves, minced

1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil (regular or lite)

2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar

1/4 teaspoon kosher salt

In medium bowl, mix all ingredients together until well combined. If too chunky for you, pulse in food processor for a few seconds. Sauce can be served as an appetizer on toast slices, with chips or on pasta. Delicious with eggs! Optional: Add crumbled Feta to taste. Keeps about three days in the refrigerator.
