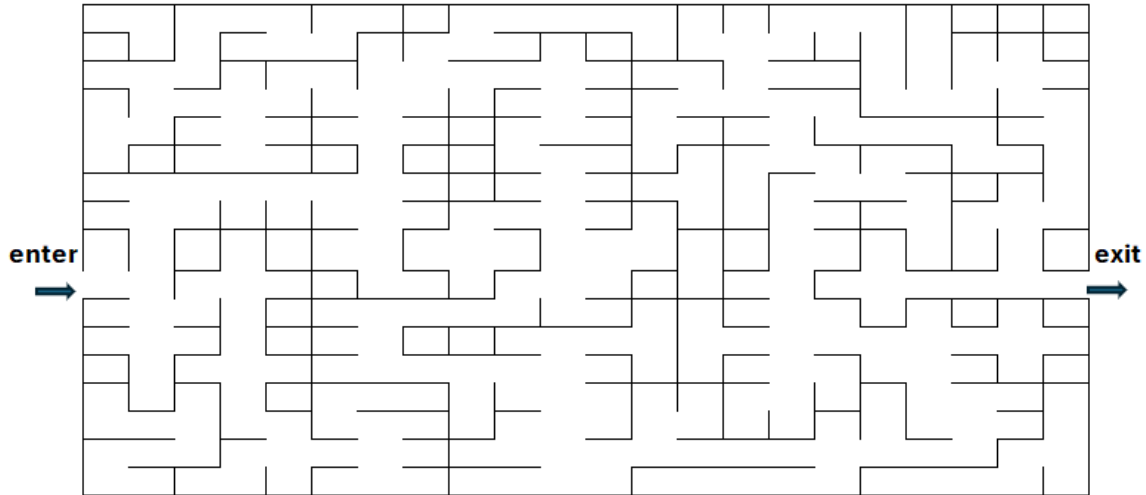

Ascension Lutheran Church Food Prep and Bag Assembly

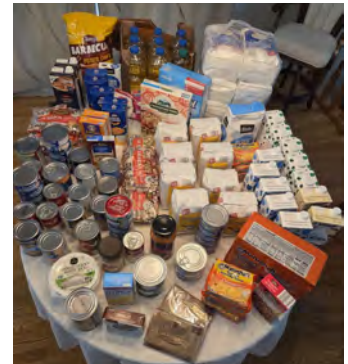
Thank you to Carla, Kathy, Kim T and Susan for helping assemble and distribute meals March 2, providing food for 268 people—great job!
